

## Master of Engineering Program in *Biomedical Engineering* Admission Requirements for Cornell University Undergraduates and Early Admission Process

- You may apply for early admission to the M.Eng. program if you have between one and eight credits left to complete your Bachelors degree.
- The last semester of your Bachelors program serves as the first semester of your M.Eng. program, although you are not officially a graduate student until you complete your B.S. degree.

### • Steps to apply:

1. **Application:** Go to: <http://www.gradschool.cornell.edu/?p=102> and fill out the application online. There will be a place to check M.Eng., early admit. An application fee of \$70 is required. Please see Belinda Floyd, (bh42@cornell.edu, 109 Weill Hall) if you are in financial need for an application fee wavier.
2. **Statement of Purpose:** This can be submitted online with the application. Your statement of purpose should be 2-3 paragraphs about why you want to earn your M.Eng. degree.
3. **Letters of Recommendation:** You will need at least two or three letters of recommendation. You can request that letters of recommendation be sent electronically by supplying the e-mail address of the recommender. Alternatively, the recommender can send the letter of recommendation directly to Belinda Floyd, (bh42@cornell.edu, 109 Weill Hall). 4. **Early Admit Petition:** You can obtain a copy of the Early Admit Petition from (Belinda Floyd, 109 Weill Hall) or online at: <http://www.engineering.cornell.edu/student-services/orgspe/academic/master-engineering/application/upload/EarlyAdmitPetition.pdf>. This petition needs to be signed by your undergraduate advisor.
5. **Transcripts:** Belinda may accept your undergraduate transcript. You do not need to request one.
6. **Graduate Record Exam:** Not required.

**Regular Admission** Follow the steps above, but omit the Early Admit Petition.

**Deadlines:** Admission is on a rolling basis.
